### General Rules

#### Be courteous!

#### NO jaywalking


No jaywalking! (Please use designated crosswalks where Linden and Rustin meet.)

#### Don't block driveways

Be polite to our neighbors and do not block driveways on Linden St. or nearby apartment complex.

#### Pull Forward

Please pull forward as much as possible to allow the maximum amount of cars.



#### Avoid showing up early

Avoid showing up early to avoid idling/blocking public bike lane on Linden St

Please Tollow our satety rules during arrival and dismissal!

7:15-7:45 AM Morning Drop Off Use the car line or park offsite and walk up to the gate.

#### Walking up to the gate?

- Don't double park
- Use the loading area only if you will be dropping off
- Don't block the entrance or exit of ANY driveways
- Use crosswalks!

- DO NOT get out of your car!
- Children should be ready to go (food, backpacks, and jackets ready to go
- To prevent accidents, once a student has left the vehicle, they are not permitted to return to the vehicle.
- Students should exit through the right side door.
- 1st day of school only: Parents may park offsite and walk their students to their classrooms.

#### Tardy?

• If your child is tardy (after 7:50 AM), you must park and accompany them to the front office or send them with a signed note explaining the reason for the tardy.

# Afternoon Pick Up

3rd-6th grade students and siblings quality For walk-off passes

Anyone picking up your student must use a dismissal placard or they will be asked to show ID in the front office.

Minimum Day TK-6th car line, 1:00 pm walk-up, walk-off passes

Forms in the office or online

'First day of school: No carline at dismissal

2:45 pm Walk-up or Drive up for TK/K

Walk-up or Drive-up for 1st-4th grade + TK/K Siblings and 3rd/4th Walk-Off students and siblings may exit 3:15 pm

Walk-up or Drive-up for 5th/6th + any younger siblings 3:30 pm

and 5th/6th Walk-Off students and siblings may exit.

Picking up after 2 PM on a minimum day or 4 PM on a regular day will result in a \$50 After School Drop In Fee

- TK/Kinder Parents using the car line: If your TK or Kinder students also have 1st-4th grade siblings, please wait until 3:15 to pick up all students. If their siblings are in 5th-6th, wait until 3:30 to pick up all students.
- Indicate your pick-up preference via the online dismissal form: Any future changes must be communicated to the office BEFORE 12 pm\*
- If your student is NOT ready for pickup, please be prepared to park (in our lot or elsewhere) and pick them up at the walk-up line.
- Any communication with the teachers is prohibited during dismissal. (Please contact the teacher for an appointment.)
- Students will stay sheltered inside until called to the dismissal car line.

# After School Program

Please contact the office 12 PM if you will be picking up early.

After School Program, tutoring, extra-curricular activities pick-up begins

2:00 pm Regular day

4:00 pm **Minimum Day** 

\* BRIDGE Program and participants in extra-curricular activity pickup starts at 4 pm on regular release days and at 2 pm on minimum days. Please contact the office 12 PM if you will be picking up early. If you do not contact the office in time, you may be asked to park and walk up to the office during the regular dismissal.
