- Dr. Rentie shared we have a higher reserve due to the possibility of expanding to a permanent location and middle school.
- Families are pleased with the school. Positive responses from students. Many are requesting to go to Middle School.
- Over half of students in ELA are proficient in each grade.
- The school has already implemented changes to increase levels in upper-grade math.
- Overall, students are performing well in ELA in comparison to last year, during a pandemic.
- Math levels have dropped in levels compared to last year; plans are already being prepared to make up for any learning loss due to pandemics.
