6.1. Director's Report

- Construction Update: New student services building is near completion. Construction is expected to be complete by mid June.
- Enrollment Update:
 - Current enrollment is 641.
 - REACH will be at full capacity with 645 students, so nearly there.
 - Next year's enrollment is robust with a total enrollment of 662 students (overenrolled by 21 students.)
 - Each year REACH experiences attrition during the summer months. By over enrolling, it takes into account the notion that some students will drop before the school year begins.
 - REACH currently has a waitlist of 180 students.
 - All grade levels are currently at capacity or are over enrolled.
 - The school has an anticipated \$2M in revenue from COVID relief funds which are not reflected in today's budget overview.

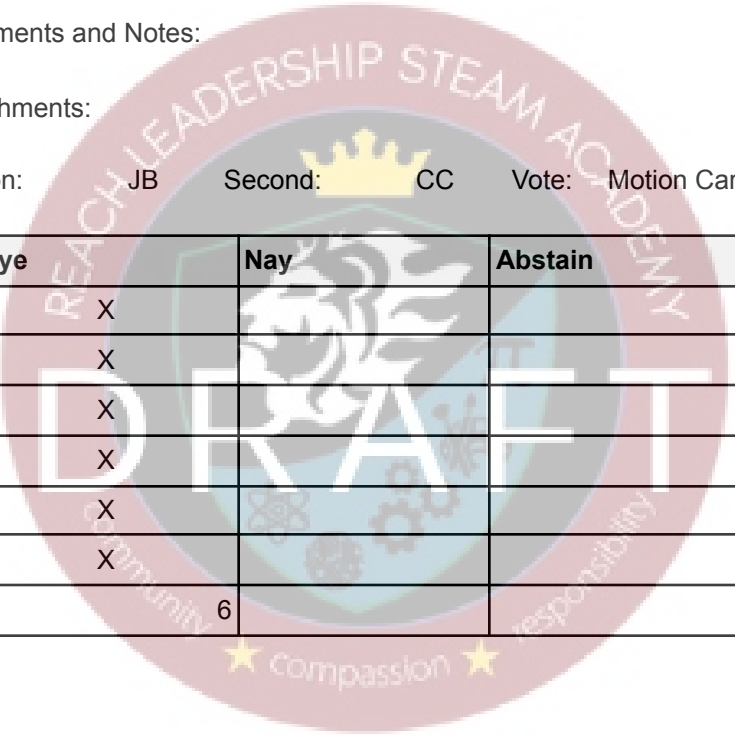
8.1. **Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant:** It is recommended that the governing board approve the Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant, also known as the ELO Grant. 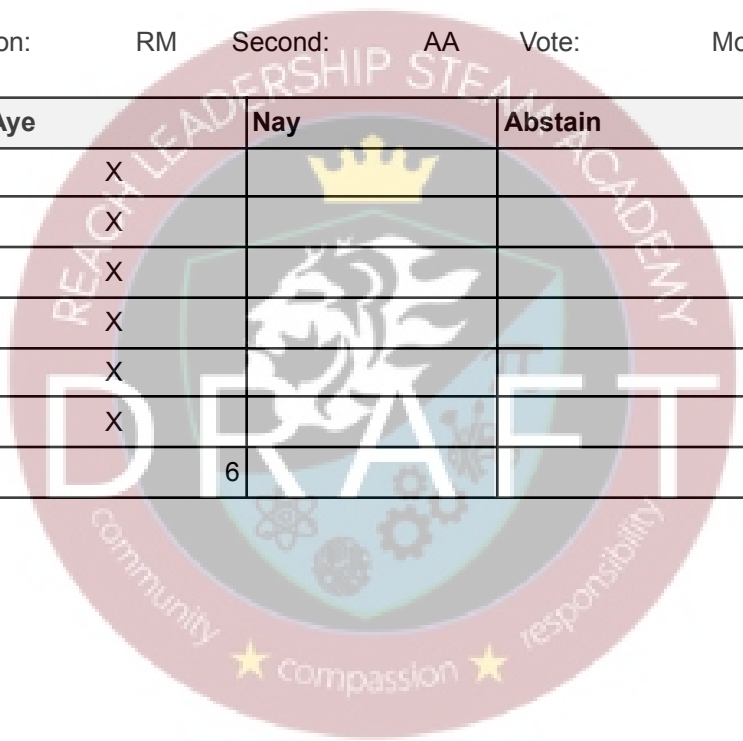
