8. Action Items

8.1. Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan (Learning Continuity Plan): The Learning Continuity and Attendance Plan (Learning Continuity Plan) is a key part of the overall budget package for K-12 that seeks to address funding stability for schools while providing information at the local educational agency (LEA) level for how student learning continuity and information on how services will be provided for unduplicated students during the ongoing COVID-19 crisis in the 2020–21 school year. The provisions for the

plan were approved by the Governor and Legislature in June in SB 98 and can be found in <u>EC Section 43509</u>. The Learning Continuity Plan replaced the Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) requirement for the 2020-21 school year.

REACH Leadership STEAM Academy held a public hearing for the Learning Continuity Plan on Monday, September 14, 2020 at 6:00 pm during a special board meeting. The Executive Director was able to review the sections of the plan and any applicable expenses related to the actions. REACH administrators and staff were able to answer questions regarding the school reopening plan and review Riverside County's Elementary School Waiver application process.
