- Budget
 - LOC paid in full! Over \$600k in debt has been paid off.
 - Do not anticipate needing to draw down on the line but timing of funding could necessitate doing so
 - PPP Loan is forgiven! We were able to locate the statement showing zero balance. Back office will go into detail as to how that impacts our budget.
- Enrollment
 - <u>Current Enrollment</u>
 - Currently pulling from waiting list to fill vacant seats



- <u>Projected enrollment by November 1</u> (depending on retention rates)
- Attendance & Average Daily Attendance (ADA)
 - Month 1- total ADA with corrections- 91.66% attendance rate
 - Month 2- 92.82% attendance rate
 - (ADA is how schools are funded.)
 - ADA is significantly lower this year due to COVID19. (Encouraging parents to keep kids home if ill as well as many students quarantining)
- RUSD Visit

- Facility Update
 - Conditional Use Permit (CUP)
 - CUP Expires June 2022
 - City is asking for a plan to make modular buildings permanent
 - School needs additional time to devise a plan for a permanent location
 - Public schools are exempt from CUP
 - Charter Schools must get approval from authorizers in order to qualify for exemptions
 - We operated under an exception at our first 2 sites.
 - Will request an exemption for our current site due to the timeline constraints.
 - Exemption does not preclude us from following building, safety or fire regulations.
 - Only exempts the us from the CUP's regulations and stipulations
 - Phase III Construction
 - Adding additional portables to create space for two current 1st grade classrooms
 - Will move a wall in a second classroom to create more space (from 20 x 30 to 20 x 40 sq ft).
 - Classroom expansion will leave room for a small resource/library room.
 - Middle School
 - Beginning phases
 - Bridges Church nearby has offered space
 - Less than 5 miles away
 - Very convenient for parents w younger siblings
 - Asked architect to create concept drawings
 - Would move the 5th & 6th grade classes to the new campus and expand to 7th & 8th gradually.
 - Timeline- 2 years
 - Projected completion date: Summer 2023

8.3. **ESSER III Expenditure Plan**: In response to the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), the U.S. Congress passed the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act, which was signed into law on March 11, 2021. The ARP Act requires local educational agencies (LEAs) that receive ESSER III funds to complete both a Safe Return to In-person Instruction and Continuity of Services plan, and an Expenditure Plan for how ESSER III funds will be used to address students' academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs, as well as the opportunity gaps that existed before, and were exacerbated by, the COVID-19 pandemic.

8.4. **Instructional Minutes 2021-22**: It is recommended that the REACH LSA governing board approve updates to the Instructional Minutes for the 2021-22 school year. There are 146 regular days and 37 minimum days of instruction, exceeding state 54,000 minimum guidelines.
