7.2. Extended Learning Opportunity Plan (ELO-P): ELO-P provides funding for after-school, summer enrichment programs, as well as intercession days for Transitional Kindergarten through 6th grade. The program is intended to provide more interactive, hands-on learning opportunities for scholars beyond the normal school day. Programs are intended to be data-driven, results-focused, pupil-centered opportunities that include community partners. It is the intent that said programs do not replicate regular learning activities throughout the school year. As outlined in its report, RLSA shall extend its calendar year to include: 3 intersession days throughout the school year, 3 additional hours daily by partnering with the BRIDGE program to provide after-school care (already in effect), as

well as an additional 27 days in the summer providing summer school and sports academy to all scholars. Enrollment preferences shall be given to scholars who qualify for Free and Reduced Price Lunch.

It is recommended that the RLSA School Board approve the Extended Learning Opportunity Program Plan in order to comply with EC Section 476120(b)(1)(B) which dictates that 30 non-school days and no less than nine hours of in-person expanded learning opportunities per day be added to the educational program. LEAs are encouraged to collaborate with community-based organizations and childcare providers to maximize the number of expanded learning opportunities offered.
