- 7.3.1. Charter Renewal
 - 7.3.1.1. Submittal of charter petition will take place this Friday.
 - 7.3.1.2. Anticipated RUSD board Hearing Thursday, June 29
 - 7.3.1.2.1. Need board and entire REACH family to support with Tshirts and excitement.
 - 7.3.1.2.2. Also requesting Material Revision to add grades 7 & 8 grades.
 - 7.3.1.2.3. The hearing for the charter renewal and the material revision will be held on the same night but will be separate action items.
 - 7.3.1.3. REACH has met the criteria for renewal established in EC § 47607(c)(2)(B)(ii):
 - 7.3.1.3.1. Notwithstanding subparagraph (A), if the two consecutive years immediately preceding the renewal decision include the 2019-20 or 2020-21 school year, the chartering authority shall not deny renewal for a charter school if either of the following apply for two of the most recent years for which state data is available preceding the renewal decision:
 - 7.3.1.3.2. (i) The charter school has received the two highest performance levels schoolwide on all the state indicators included in the evaluation rubrics adopted pursuant to Section 52064.5 for which it receives performance levels.
 - 7.3.1.3.3. (ii) For all measurements of academic performance, the charter school has received performance levels schoolwide that are the same or higher than the state average and, for a majority of subgroups performing statewide below the state average in each respective year; received performance levels that are higher than the state average. (Emphasis added.)
 - 7.3.1.3.4. The two years preceding the renewal decision for which state data is available are 2019 and 2022. In both of these years, REACH attained performance levels schoolwide that are higher than the state average. Further, in 2019 and 2022 REACH had numerically significant subgroups that completed testing (n > 30). Each of these REACH subgroups received performance levels that are higher than the state average.
