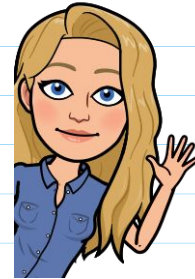

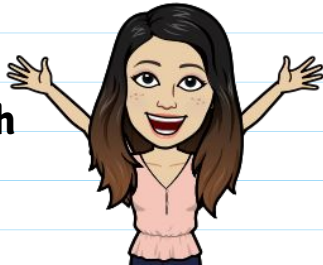

Nightly Routine @ Home

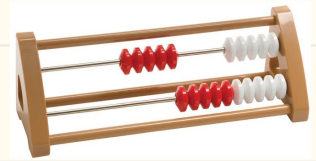
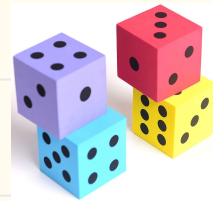
- Check and clean out folders and backpacks daily!

- Folder: Bring every day



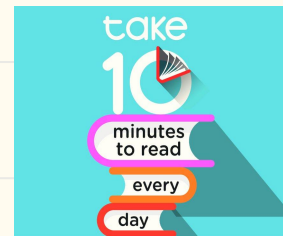
- Homework:

A Brief Look Into the Curriculum




- **Curriculum Overview**


- TK implements hands on learning while completing centers.
- Work varies from independent, partner, and teacher centered.
- Whole brain teaching strategies.
- Language arts focuses on alphabetic principle, sight words, and cvc words.
- Math focuses on number sense and number and shape recognition.



A Brief Look Into the **Kinder** Curriculum



- **Curriculum Overview**

- Kindergarten at REACH is very "hands on" with a large amount of the day devoted to centers based activities utilizing a lot of manipulatives. The students work independently in small groups during center time which allows the teacher time to also work with different small groups based on whatever level they need. The teachers use "Whole Brain Teaching" strategies when working with the entire group and also use music to transition between different activities.

Uniform



Uniform/Dress Code

Shirts:

- Oxford white button down shirt (NO polo shirts)

All jackets and coats:

- SOLID navy, black, or white


Pants, shorts, skirts, and jumpers:

- Navy or khaki (No jeans or cargo shorts/pants)
 - Button down shirts must be worn under jumpers

Socks and tights:

- SOLID navy or white.

Shoes:

- MUST be close-toed Athletic shoes ONLY and socks must always be worn for safety reasons. (No boots except on rainy days.)
-  Velcro strapped shoes are encouraged for Kinders

Spirit Days:

● **Wednesdays:**

University/College shirt with uniform bottoms or blue jeans (no rips or holes)

● **Fridays:** House color clothes or shirts

- House shirts can be purchased in the office
- Jeans, sweats, athletic shorts in house colors okay. No leggings.

SCHOOL UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS



HATS

Optional:
Hats and beanies must be plain black, navy, or white, no logo



* No hats or beanies in classrooms

TOPS

White, oxford button down style shirts

* No polo shirts!
Shirts must button all the way down.

JACKETS/SWEATERS

Jackets and sweaters must be solid navy, white or black

* No pullover or hooded sweatshirts, no jean jackets



Navy blue v-neck sweater vests are optional...



Navy blue ties may be worn on Tuesdays.



Any undershirts must be white



Solid colors!
No logos!

BOTTOMS

Navy blue or khaki pants, shorts, skirts, jumpers, and skirts.

Belts, if worn, must be solid black or navy.



Chino style or khakis. No cargo pockets, no leggings, no jeggings!



! Uniform shirts must always be worn under jumpers. Peter Pan collars are preferred.



FOOT WEAR

Athletic style, closed toe shoes--suitable for PE



Boots may only be worn on rainy days. Crocs or sandals may only be worn on water play days.

May be any color, lace-up or velcro



Socks, tights, and leggings (worn under skirts) must be solid navy or white*

All students must wear socks, tights, or leggings with their shoes.

*Black socks may be worn with pants.

ALTERNATIVE UNIFORM DAYS



WEDNESDAYS



College/University Day

Students may wear a college/university shirt or long-sleeved shirt or sweatshirt with uniform bottoms or blue jeans.

ASSEMBLY DAYS



No Free Dress for Award Assemblies
Students may not use free dress passes on these days.

FREE DRESS DAYS



Monthly Classroom Awarded Free Dress for Best Attendance

Some classrooms are awarded free dress on certain days for an entire month after the class wins best attendance. See the teacher for instructions.

Free Dress Passes

Students may receive free dress passes that they may use on any day besides Award Assembly Days.

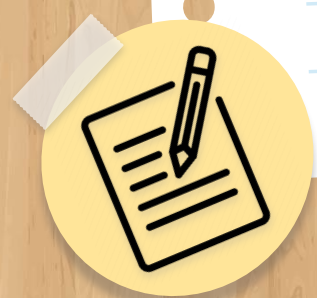

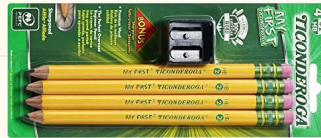

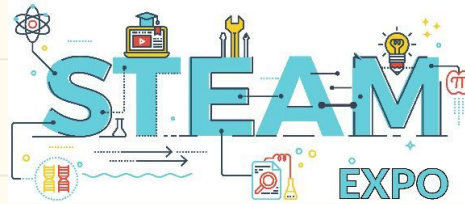

- The data will allow the teacher to better accommodate your child's academic needs.
- The data will help the teacher plan differentiated small group instructions at the start of the school year. ✓
